Rules:

1. You must have a valid fishing license as required by law - ages 15 and older - and must be presented at weigh in to qualify for fishing derby participation and prizes.
2. One RAFFLE TICKET enters you into the derby, entitles you to refreshments and provides a chance to win a number of great raffle prizes.
3. Raffle tickets may be purchased from volunteers going door to door or at Goulet's Beach (Post 21 on the south shore of the lake) and on the day of the derby. Purchase as many Raffle Tickets as you like to have a better chance of winning some fantastic prizes but more importantly it is a fantastic way to show support for the Derby.
4. Report to Goulet's Beach with your catch by NOON (Derby sign will be displayed on beach)
5. Derby Fishing shall be from dawn until noon, lunch from 11:30pm until 1:30pm & ALL prizes awarded after lunch.
6. Do not exceed speed limit of 8 mph on the lake at any time.
7. Fish measurers (your judges) shall have the right, at their discretion, to reject suspect fish from the contest if suspected to be previously frozen, extremely stiff or cloudy eyed fish (more so than simple cataracts). ☺
8. Prizes awarded in each of the following Men's and Women's Age Groups: 0-8, 9-14, 15-59, 60+
9. Prize Categories in each Age Group shall be: Biggest Fish, Most Legal Size Trout Caught. Also biggest Non-Trout Prize for Men and Women
10. Only one cash prize shall be awarded for the biggest overall fish caught. In the event of a tie a person with the next largest fish shall be deemed the winner. In the event that no third fish was entered then the cash prize shall be split evenly among the two largest fish winners.
11. And most of all ... EVERYONE MUST HAVE FUN!
