The **Angle Lake Shore Club** is pleased to announce the return of both the annual fishing derby and our Independence Day fireworks display! We urge all area residents, old and new, to join in the festivities. Our fishing derby is a great way to be a part of the neighborhood whether you like to fish or not. And after a break of a couple years the shore club, with the partnership of the city, promises the best fireworks show we've ever staged!

This year the derby will be held **Sunday May 15th** at a new location, the Todd/Langenbach shore at the corner of 39th and 192nd. If coming by land, park near that corner or near the end of S 191st Pl. By sea, look for the red EAT sign to find us. We'll have coffee and donuts for the landlubbers starting around 9AM and a bonfire to stay a bit warm. Anglers have all morning to land their catch as long as they get them in for judging by noon. (Be sure to have the appropriate fishing license.) Around noon we'll serve lunch for everyone. Burgers, salmon, sides and soft drinks. Bring the family and get acquainted/acquainted with your neighbors! And after lunch will be time to award prizes to those catching the most, biggest and oddist fish in different age categories. We will also host a raffle with lots of fabulous prizes including an **electric bike** so anyone can be a winner! Tickets For the derby are still only \$5 each, 3 for \$10 and 10 for \$20 and are good for both the meal and the raffle. Your support helps us put on this event so please be generous!

Due to the pandemic we've missed the lakewide **July 4th Independence Day** party that is the hallmark of living in the Angle Lake community. So let's bring it back big! This year features - shall we say **fireworks from all angles!** Fireworks will launch from the traditional barge at the elbow of the lake as well as from 2 additional barges at the midpoints of each lake leg. A three ring circus of spectacular you won't want to miss!

Of course the whole day will be filled with Independence Day festivities: The Bud Jones run/walk around the lake in the morning, the Angle Lake Manor Parade, dock judging, paddleboard races, swimming races, parade of boats and our ring of fire flares.

With the expanded fireworks show and other expenses the club asks for the support of the community. Both the fishing derby and the fireworks happen due to the generosity of the whole neighborhood! Volunteers will be canvassing the area in early May collecting for these events - both selling raffle tickets (over)

for the Fishing Derby and collecting donations for Fourth of July activities. Please help support these events! Suggested donation for the fireworks is \$150 for houses on the lakeside and lesser for those houses off lake. The volunteers will also have tickets for the derby and raffle - remember, \$5 for one, \$10 for 3, or \$20 for 10
