## Welcome to Angle Lake

Did you know there are two organizations that make our neighborhood special?

They are: the Angle Lake Manor (ALM) and the Angle Lake Shore Club (ALSC)

**The ALM** is a Homeowners Club of the 124 homes that share ownership of the Private Angle Lake Manor Beach Lot at 3417 S. 194th. Homes included are all homes on the South side of S 192nd and all homes between there and the lake from the Angle Lake Park to 39th Ave S.

Bi-Monthly meetings are open to all ALM homeowners or tenants. They are usually on the second Thursday of the month and held at the beach lot in the summer months. There are many volunteer opportunities and we invite you to join in and become a part of the energy, fun and responsibility we share in this close knit and caring community.

Meetings discuss our Neighborhood Watch program, the use and maintenance of the beach lot and four major events run by ALM:

- 1. The Fourth of July Kiddie Parade & ice cream social with live music
- 2. The National Night out Against Crime Potluck in August,
- 3. The Holiday Party, Potluck and White Elephant gift exchange in December
- 4. The Annual Yard Sale around the Labor Day weekend

Dues are \$40 a year to support maintenance of the beach lot and organization. One key to the beach lot is given to all paid members. Replacement keys cost \$20. Rules are posted at the entrance. Important to note is the covenant forbidding public access to the beach lot. ALM ownership of the lot will return to the developer, if non-members are allowed to access it without a member present.

Flyers delivered door to door are an occasional mode of communication. But we prefer to communicate through email and short text reminders. We have established a phone tree to reach residents quickly in case of emergency.
